5. Well stocked library with adequate reading area. (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
 6. Well-developed indoor and outdoor sports facilities. (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
 7. Well-developed Digital Infrastructure (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-10/2023 dated 24.03.2023)

Failure to comply within the prescribed time may invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- per month until compliance is submitted and may debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students' class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

SUBJECT: - UPGRADATION TO SENIOR SECONDARY LEVEL - REGARDING.

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 17, of which not more than 4 sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 for a classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension. The school is directed to run at least 01 section each of Bal-Vatika I, II & III in accordance with established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
2	The school does not seem to have referred to RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board for CwSN toilets. . Instead of grab bars on both sides of WC, as mandated, a single rod is affixed to one side. The school building is G+5, but only two CwSN toilets for boys are seen in the inspection video. As per board's circular no. 11/2024 dated 09.08.2024, separate CwSN toilets for girls and boys should be maintained on the ground floor of the school building. If classes are conducted on any floor other than the ground floor, separate CwSN compliant toilets for boys and girls with adequate space for the Wheelchair / Walker must mandatorily be maintained on those floor(s) as well. School shall comply with the guidelines for CwSN as per board's circular dated 09.08.2024, within 03 months and submit compliance with videography.
3	Ramp/lift for accessing the upper floors has not been covered in the inspection video; hence, availability of the same with required infrastructural facilities can not be

	ascertained and verified. As per board's circular no. 11/2024 dated 09.08.2024, if the school conducts classes or Practicals for CwSN on any floor other than the ground floor, it shall mandatorily make provisions for a lift or ramp to access those floors. School shall comply with the guidelines for CwSN as per board's circular dated 09.08.2024, within 03 months and submit compliance with videography.
4	Computer lab is under sized and under stocked. School has less number of computers as specified in SoP issued by the Board vide Circular No.11 dated 04.10.2022. As per inspection committee report, school has 20 computers. School shall shift the lab to the bigger room having dimensions as per board's SOPs and also to increase the number of computers to minimum 40, within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
5	Library appears to be under stocked for senior secondary level. School should have more books specially in reading section such as story books, novels, biographies etc. in different languages. Further, separate reading area for staff/teachers is not seen in the library. School shall upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board and submit compliance on SARAS portal within 3 months.
6	The composite science lab has not been set-up as per the Board's SoP. Utilities like water and gas connections have not been provided on the work-stations in Composite science lab. Safety measure like exhaust fans have not been installed in the lab. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the composite science lab as per board's SOPs, within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.
7	Mathematics lab has not been set-up as per board's SOPs. The mathematics lab seems to be temporarily established without appropriate furniture for the labs. Few small wooden tables have been arranged in the lab. The Maths lab needs to have appropriate furniture, more kits, teaching aids, student activity material and manipulative along with proper storage facility and seating arrangements. The school shall accordingly upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	The science specific labs have some deficiencies. School has made inadequate seating arrangement in the Physics, Chemistry and Biology labs. Safety features like fire extinguishers and exhaust fans have not been installed in the Chemistry lab. Biology and Chemistry labs do not have gas connection on the work-stations. The unfinished flooring work of the labs is still to be completed. The school shall upgrade the science specific labs as per board's SOPs, within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.
9	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Panchkula within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time

and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.

5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
